Wrens	We have been learning all about Jack and the Beanstalk. We have also been cooking different sorts of foods.
Robins	We have been learning about lots of different flowers and plants that we have in our gardens and writing poems about them.
Woodpeckers	We have been exploring some of the books nominated for the 'Kate Greenaway Award', particularly 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. We created our own stories about refugees and decided that we would help Christian Aid by raising money to support refugees around the world. In Maths, we have been thinking about co-ordinates and measurements. In PE, we have been developing our athletics skills with Mr Stephens.
Owls	In Maths, Owls have been solving measure problems involving money and time and in English the children have been completing a range of descriptive writing in the form of poems and describing characters and settings. In RE, we have been exploring how Jesus is inspiring to some people by finding evidence in bible stories. We use the evidence which we found to create some art work.
Peregrines	In English Year 6 have been busy writing a guide on how to survive SATs for children in Year 5 and in Maths they have been designing their own theme park and calculating the cost to set it up, whilst in Year 5 they have been describing characters and settings in English and converting measurements in Maths. Also, the children have audition for parts in the forthcoming summer concert. All of the main parts have been given out to the children, so they can learn their lines over the half-term break.
