**The facts of lice**

Each year, head lice affect 12 million kids, ages 3-11.

**What are lice?**  
Lice are tiny insects that live on the scalp and hair. They are most common on the head, but can also be found on the body and pubic hair.

**How to check for lice**  
Lice are most likely to be found on the scalp, behind the ears, and at the nape of the neck. To check for lice, use a fine-toothed comb to comb through the hair, section by section.

**How to treat head lice**  
1. Wash the head with a lice shampoo or conditioner. 2. Check the hair for lice. 3. Clean any items that may have lice on them. 4. Repeat the process every 7-10 days.

**How to reduce your child's risk**  
1. Avoid sharing hats, hairbrushes, or hair accessories. 2. Avoid sharing towels or clothing. 3. Avoid sharing combs or hairbrushes.

**Head lice symptoms**  
• Head lice cause itching on the scalp, neck, and behind the ears. • Itching is caused by the lice's saliva. • There may be small red bumps on the scalp, neck, and behind the ears.
