So far our bricks have helped to build ten schools and they are now starting another project to buy families corn and goats to help them to be self-sufficient. The children looked at photographs of the children's homes and schools. After that Carol showed us with string the size of the classrooms that house one hundred children and just one teacher, who is paid a dollar a day. Not quite sure what the teaching unions would say about that! My thanks go to Carol and Gren for their fantastic work in Burundi and all of our families who support our clubs with your 10 pence pieces.

Next Wednesday, at the beginning of the day, the children will be sharing their thanks for 'Harvests around the World' at St. Giles'. I am very sad that I will be in Birmingham at an important conference that day but hope that it is enjoyed by all. As in previous years we would appreciate Harvest donations that we will pass on to the Ross Community Larder. This enables families living below the poverty line to access non-perishable items. 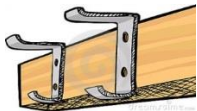
