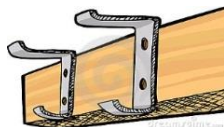
News from the classes

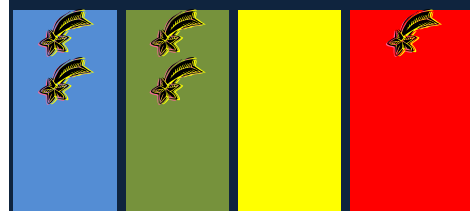
