Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to the Summer Term

We hope that you had an enjoyable Easter break and that the children are ready for another busy term in Woodpeckers.

During the first half term will be continuing with our 'Mayan Mania' topic as will the rest of KS2. We will then be moving onto a topic about the local community of Goodrich. Please find attached the topic web explaining what we will be covering in each subject of the curriculum.

In Woodpeckers, the children will continue to be taught by Miss Wright and supported by either Mrs Lafford (mornings) or Mrs Watling (some afternoons). On Wednesday mornings the children will be taught by Mrs Dix. There will also be opportunities when the children work with different children and staff within school.

We encourage parents to support their child's learning at home. We understand that children are often busy or tired after school but would like the children to try and read aloud at home as regularly as possible. Please write any comments and sign your child's reading record when you have listened to them read. We will also send home their red homework book on Friday. Homework should be sent back into school by the following **Wednesday** to give everybody the opportunity to complete this on time.

All the children will be participating in P.E. lessons throughout the week, so it is important that they have their P.E. kit in school everyday. If your child takes part in a sporting after school club, you may find it easier for them to bring in another set of kit for this.

The P.E. kit should consist of:

- * **Short sleeved T – shirt** – plain white
- * **Shorts** – plain black or navy
- * **Tracksuit bottoms** – plain black or navy (for outdoor P.E.)
- * **Jumper / fleece** – plain (for outdoor P.E.)
- * **Socks** – white
- * **P.E. pumps / trainers** - suitable for physical activity

Please ensure that your child wears sensible black shoes everyday so that they can move safely around school and the playground. Hopefully the weather will continue to improve so they will need to bring in a sunhat. They may also bring in sun cream labelled with their name to be kept in class for them to apply independently.
