Final Information and Reminders

Dear Parents/Guardians,

There are less than two weeks until we go to Llangorse!

Firstly, thank you for completing and returning the statutory forms. The relevant information (medical and dietary) has been passed onto the staff at Llangorse.

Below are approximate times and dates for the week at Llangorse:

Monday 18th May

- 08:55 - Children to be in school. Luggage, etc. - to be put in the hall.
- 11:00 - Depart from school
- 13:00 - Arrive at Llangorse

Friday 23rd May

- 13:00 - Depart from Llangorse
- 14:30 - Arrive back at school.

Please ensure your child brings all the necessary kit - labelled - for the week as detailed in the list given at the information meeting.

Key additional things to remember:

- Packed lunch and drink for eating once we arrive at Llangorse;
- Medicine (if required, e.g. travel sickness and hay fever tablets, inhalers) clearly labelled with the child's name on the medicine, a letter detailing previous dosage taken that day, dosage and frequency to be given while away. Please give medicine/s & letter to Mrs Freeman/Mrs Cleaver;
- Pocket money - max £10 in a named purse/wallet. Please give purse/wallet to Miss Blowfield/Miss Davey/Miss Newman;
- Suncream and sunhat
- Camera - disposable ideally;
- NO electric equipment, mobile phones, IPODS, any other valuables or chewing gum.
