School Prayer

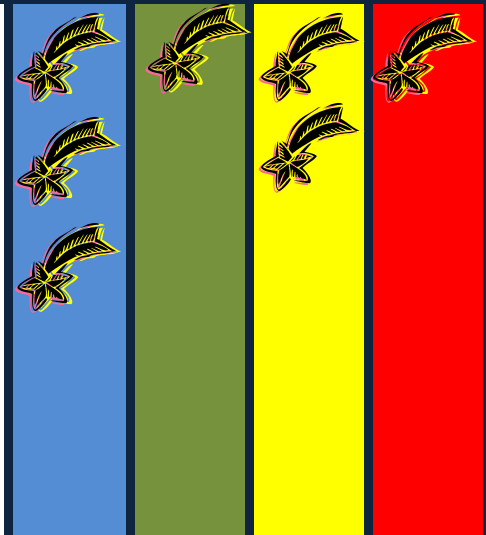
Dear God,
