<b>Robins</b>	This week the Robins have been learning our new class poem called Imagine. It is all about Bonfire Night. We have been making our own flames and writing adjectives and similes to describe them. Toward the end of the week, we have started to change the class poem to make our own. In Maths, Year 2 have been finding secret number patterns using 2 more, 2 less, 10 more and 10 less. <b>Woodpeckers</b>	Woodpeckers have been linking multiplication and division facts in Maths this week. In English, we have been thinking about how we can use different types of words to create interesting character descriptions. <b>Owls</b>	In Maths this week, we have been learning how to solve problems involving numbers with up to two decimal places. In English, we have been developing story ideas. <b>Peregrines</b>	In English this week we have been considering characters, settings and plots for our tragedy narrative. We have been using art to plan our ideas.
