Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome to 'The Robins!'

Here are a few things that you will need to know.

Your child will continue to receive free fruit at morning break. The children are allowed to bring in their own snack, but as a 'Healthy School' we ask that this is a healthy snack.

Your child will need a full PE kit in school and this includes trainers for outdoor PE and daps for inside PE. PE lessons will be on Tuesday afternoons and Friday mornings but are occasionally on other days.

Forest School will be every other Wednesday afternoon (see newsletter/ ourschoolsapp for dates). Your child can come in Forest School Clothes and I would suggest that they bring their school uniform to change back into as they may get wet and muddy. Please can you ensure your child brings in their own wellies, which can be left on the fence surrounding our outside area if you are happy to do so. Please can all other forest school clothes be taken home every week as the cloak room is too small to store it all.

Children are allowed to bring in their own pencil case. This is optional as all of the equipment that your child will need is provided in school. Please ensure that all of your child's belongings are clearly named.

Reading at home with an adult is an important part of homework. Please enjoy sharing and talking about the book and make comments in your child's reading record. Written homework will be given out every Friday to be returned on a Monday. Spellings will be given out on Mondays, more details can be found in the spellings book sent home. They should be learned throughout the week at home and are tested on a Friday in school. The spelling book can be kept at home all week but is needed in class on Friday mornings. Homework will usually start on the second week of each half term.

If you have any concerns or queries, please do make an appointment (via the School Office) to come in and see me or have a chat with me on the gate after school.
