Make sure you are wrapped up in a T-shirt, and wear shorts and sunglasses.

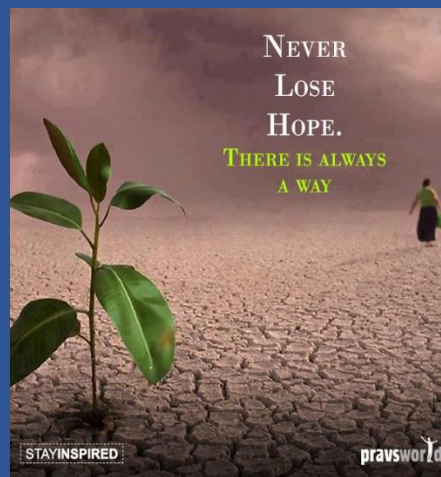


Splat!
