

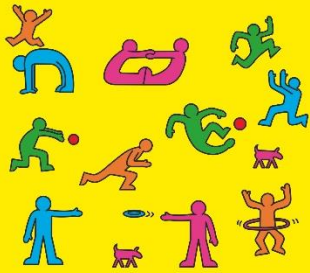

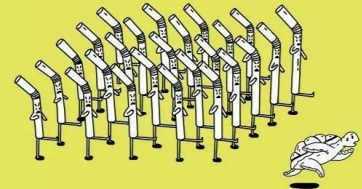

**Stop the army of plastic. Don't ask for a straw.**



