Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Summer Term! We hope you all had an enjoyable Easter holiday with family and friends.

For the Summer Term our topic is about the Stone Age to Iron Age. On the back of this letter is an overview of the learning that has been planned. We plan to give children some experiences through forest school, cooking, Art and drama. As a kick start to our topic we will visit St Fagans Museum of History to get a sense of what life was like during this period and participate in an Iron Age farmstead workshop. This will hopefully give the children a foundation on which to build their knowledge as the term progresses.

Clubs will resume next week (beginning *Monday 6th May*) and Forest school dates for Woodpeckers can be found on the school app or on the school newsletter. Remember, to send your child in suitable and practical clothing, which you don't mind if it gets dirty or ripped. No 'best clothes' or skirts.

Homework will continue to be given out on Thursday, for it to be handed in on the following Tuesday. As well as homework, it is important that your child reads regularly each week and practice their times tables linking multiplication and division facts with quick recall.
