Entering & Leaving School

Timings

Uniform

Children will wear normal school uniform (including school shoes). Please wash and change uniform as you would normally.

PE kits should contain trainers/daps and bottoms suitable for physical activity (shorts/joggers).

On a Forest School day (this information will come from your teacher in the first week), children can come to school in Forest School clothes.

Lunch

The hall will only be used for [Breakfast Club](#), [hot school lunches](#) and [Smiles](#).

The hall will be cleaned thoroughly after [Breakfast Club](#), [before and after each sitting for lunch and after Smiles](#). All children will enter and leave the hall as a class.

Playtimes and lunchtimes will be staggered. Normally we like all children to eat together but packed lunches will currently be eaten in the classroom at the same time as other children from their class have hot dinners in the hall. This is to ensure that the number in the hall are kept to a minimum. They will have playtime with their class.

Outside areas will be divided [into three zones](#), so that the outdoor area can be used for learning as much as possible by as many groups as possible. This worked very well in the summer term.

Notes

Clubs will not run for at least the first half term (including Circuits) but [Breakfast Club](#) and [Smiles](#) will be available every day.

There will not be any whole school events, including collective worship.

Parents will not be admitted to site except in a critical emergency.

Reading books will come home and will be cleaned before returning to school stock.

Parent groups should not form on the school site before and after school.

Staff within school will clean all used surface, toilets and empty bins at lunch time. Bins & surfaces will be cleaned at the end of the day and again over night.

Whilst currently under review, masks will not currently be worn on site, except in specific instances set out in the guidance. It is of course acceptable for adults to wear a mask when dropping off and picking up children.
