Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope you all had a lovely Easter break. It has been wonderful to hear the children talking about what they have been up to and about family members they have been able to see, that they have not seen for a long time.

Welcome back to the Summer Term! I thought I would inform you of a few things that you will need to know about.

On the back of this letter is an overview of the learning that has been planned for this half term. In Science, we will be focusing on 'Rocks' and in Geography we will be looking at physical features and processes including rivers, mountains and volcanoes.

A P.E. kit (white t-shirt, navy or black shorts and a pair of trainers) will be required for P.E. on Tuesday afternoons, however it is recommended that their P.E. kits stay in school at all times.

Throughout the week, we will continue to do our Daily Mile (Run a Mile) or Physical Activities to promote being active and having a healthy lifestyle and to help your child concentrate in the classroom. Please ensure that children have a pair of trainers or daps in school, so that they can change into after lunch.

On a Wednesday afternoon, the children will have Forest School. Please refer to the bottom of the newsletter or the school app to find out which dates your child will be involved in forest school and the clothing they need to wear.

Homework (English and Maths) will continue to be given out on Thursdays and to be handed in on the following Tuesdays. Spelling homework will be given out on Mondays in their Home Spellings Book. Their spellings need to be learned throughout the week and the book needs to be returned ready for their spelling test on Friday. As well as homework, it is important that your child learns their times tables and reads regularly during the week to an adult and independently. Please record each time you hear your child read in their reading record book.
