



Remote Learning at Goodrich Primary School

This plan outlines the three types of Remote Learning which will be offered to children if their learning is disrupted by Covid between September 2021 – July 2022. It is not anticipated that there will be a return to whole school closures nationally and class closures will be a last resort (see Covid Contingency Plan Sept 2021). However, it is likely that some children will have to miss school because they have asymptomatic Covid. It is also possible that, should there be a major Covid outbreak within school, whole classes may have to move to home learning for 10 school days. If your child is ill with Covid, or any other illness, they won't be expected to complete any home learning.

There are three different types of home learning available:

Who is this for?	This is for individual children who can't attend school because they have Covid, but don't have symptoms so can continue to access learning at home during isolation.	This is for whole classes who have been moved to remote learning for 10 school days because there has been a significant outbreak which continues to spread.	It is not expected that there will be a need to close the whole school as a result of Covid. However, should this be necessary, then this home learning will be provided.
How will the learning be structured?	<p>As the teacher will still be teaching the rest of the class in school, and as we have ensured that all children have a digital device to access live lessons, the teacher will provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to live teaching via Zoom so that the child can participate in the class learning at the same time as their peers in reading, writing and maths lessons (although we will endeavour to provide live learning for other subjects too). 	<p>As the whole class will be working from home, the teacher will teach the curriculum via Zoom. 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<p>How will the teacher keep in touch with my child?</p>	<p>As this will be a short absence of 10 days, the teacher will email the parent to check that they understand the home learning and be available via email to respond to any queries at the end of the day.</p> <p>A staff member will phone parents of children with Special Educational Needs or other vulnerabilities.</p>	<p>The teacher will 'check-in' with all the children every day via the twice daily registration Zoom call.</p> <p>Teaching Assistants /at will complete individual Zoom calls to support children with their learning as directed by their teacher.</p>	<p>The teacher will 'check-in' with all the children every day via the twice daily registration Zoom call.</p> <p>Teaching Assistants will complete individual Zoom calls to support children with their learning as directed by their teacher.</p> <p>Children with an EHCP will be supported in home learning through contact with their Teacher or TA if appropriate, although all children with an EHCP will be offered a place at school.</p>
